PARTS

- Firepit w/Tank Doors
- Lava Rock Grid
- Bag of Lava Rocks
- 4 Faux (Cement) Logs

REQUIREMENTS

- 5 Gallon Propane Tank
- Propane Fuel
- Outdoor Use Only
- 10' from Walls/Buildings
- Level Non-Flammable Surface

SET-UP

- Place Grid within well
- Top Grid with Lava Rocks
- Top Rocks with Logs

CLEAN-UP

- Close Propane Tank Valve
- Turn control knob to OFF
- Remove propane tank before transporting.
- Allow unit to cool for 45 minutes before touching

OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS

1. Open doors and make sure the control knob is in the OFF position
2. Pull out the tank drawer and place propane tank into the tank tray.
3. Connect the propane tank (*see instruction page*)
4. Test for gas leaks (use soapy water)
5. Open the valve on the propane tank & slide tank drawer into place.
6. Turn the control knob straight up to the LOW position.
7. With your left hand, push in and hold the control knob .
8. With your right hand, press the red ignitron button and hold. Wait 5 seconds to light firepit.
9. Once lit, continue to press the control knob down. After 45 seconds release the control knob
10. If it does not ignite after 45 seconds, release, wait 5 minutes and try again.
11. If it does not light, attempt with a long match / lighter.
12. Adjust the flame to the desired level with control knob.

WARNING

- **DO NOT SIT ON MANTLE!**
- Children and pets should be kept away at a safe distance
- No flammable liquids or vapors within 25 ft.
- Do not use solid fuels (wood/charcoals/paper etc.)
